TOWN OF RHINEBECK SUMMER EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES

SUMMER CAMP DIRECTOR: This position pays between \$20-\$25 per hour depending on experience. Candidate must have a Bachelor's Degree **OR** be at least 21 years of age, and must have at least 24 weeks of administrative or supervising experience in camping or the equivalent.

AQUATICS DIRECTOR: This position pays between \$20-\$25 per hour and includes free certification/re-certification. Oversees swim lessons and lifeguards, and is present during hours of summer camp to assess campers' swimming levels/abilities for safety. Must be at least 21 years of age.

CAMP COUNSELORS & LIFEGUARDS: \$12 per hour. The Town will cover the cost of certification for up to 10 lifeguards age 17 and over who can work the full season (Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day). All camp counselors will be trained in First Aid / CPR.

The Town of Rhinebeck is covering the cost of FREE Water Safety Instructor (WSI) training and certification for up to 10 people as well as management certification for the Aquatics Director. Applicants must be 17 or older to be eligible and must be able to work for the entire season (Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day). Certification training will be held at the indoor pool at Bard College from 10am to 6pm on Saturday Feb. 16, Sunday Feb. 17 and Monday Feb. 18, 2019 (plus nine hours of online learning). Must be a good swimmer! Pre-course: 25 yards of Front Crawl, Back Crawl, Butterfly & Breaststroke.
