Notice on the Coronavirus

Following directions and recommendations from the State of New York, Dutchess County and their respective Departments of Public Health concerning the Coronavirus (COVID-19), the Town of Rhinebeck is taking the following steps for the protection of its citizens:

- All non-Town meetings or gatherings on Town Property or in Town Facilities are cancelled through April 30, 2020 or until further notice.
- Official Town meetings will take place until further notice, but attendees should practice social distancing from each other.
- Residents are asked to call the respective Town Departments with whom they have business before coming to Town Hall. The public is also asked to deposit any non-urgent paperwork (such as tax payments, requests for vital records, change of address forms, permit requests, etc.) in the Town Hall drop box located at the front door of Town Hall. We will process your payments and paperwork and mail records and receipts to you.
